- Provide complete comprehensive nursing assessments and administers appropriate treatment/course of action based upon this assessment.
- Provide general nursing care to clients in keeping with nursing standards
- Develop and implement treatment plans in consultation with other multidisciplinary team members
- Provide health teaching and supports to client
- Make appropriate hospital and community referrals and follow up as needed
- Work collaboratively with other SHC staff and community organizations to improve client care, service delivery, and coordination

These positions require the ability to work flexible shifts including regular days, evenings, and Saturdays.

- Current Registration with the Ontario College of Nurses in the General Class
- BScN preferred
- 3 to 5 years demonstrated nursing experience in a community health (or similar) setting
- Familiarity with communities facing barriers to accessing health care due to social isolation, homelessness, mental health and/or substance abuse issues
- Proven ability to problem solve effectively and independently
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively within a multidisciplinary team
- Availability to work flexible hours including days, evenings, and Saturdays
- Solid interpersonal and crisis intervention skills
- Experience and comfort working with an electronic charting system is an asset
