



***H1N1 Flu and Seasonal Flu Information
November 17, 2009***

Sherbourne's Flu Assessment Centre (FAC)

The number of people with flu symptoms has increased in Toronto. To support our community, Sherbourne Health Centre has partnered with Toronto Public Health to open a Flu Assessment Centre starting on November 18, 2009.

The FAC will be open Monday to Friday from 1:30pm until 7:30pm and on Saturday from 9:30am until 12:30pm. The FAC is open to everyone who may be experiencing flu-like symptoms. Doctors, nurse practitioners and nurses will assess and treat individuals. Treatment will involve education about influenza and how to manage this illness. Treatment may involve the use of antiviral medications as recommended by the most recent provincial guidelines.

**There will not be any H1N1 or Seasonal Flu Vaccine Provided at the FAC.
